

Chairman Norm Weaver called the Monday June 19, 2017 meeting of the Hughes County Board of Commissioners to order at 5:30 PM with members Roger Inman, Tom Tveit, Jim Hardwick and Bill M. Abernathy present. County Manager Kevin Hipple, Emergency Manager Rob Fines, and Sheriff Mike Leidholt were also present. The meeting began with a prayer by Pastor John Fette and the Pledge of Allegiance.

**AGENDA:** Moved by Abernathy and seconded by Inman to approve the agenda. All voted aye. Motion passed.

**MINUTES:** Moved by Hardwick and seconded by Inman to approve the minutes of the June 5, 2017 Commission meeting. All voted aye. Motion passed.

**FIREWORKS PERMISSION:** Moved by Tveit and seconded by Abernathy to approve a permit for Spring Creek Resort to hold a public fireworks display on July 1, 2017, David Healan from Spring Creek Resort agreed if a burn ban was in place, the event would be cancelled. SDGFP had previously approved this event contingent on having a fire tender on standby. All voted aye. Motion passed.

**DROUGHT DIASTER RESOLUTION:** Moved by Tveit and seconded by Inman to approve the Drought Disaster Resolution 2017-07. All voted aye. Motion passed.

**Resolution 2017-07  
Drought Disaster Declaration**

WHEREAS, Hughes County suffers from a lack of rain in the late spring and summer of this year, resulting in a natural disaster in the form of agricultural drought conditions, including inadequate winter snowfall, inadequate rainfall, desolating winds, and late frost conditions, the Board of County Commissioners resolve that said drought conditions constitute a natural disaster of such severity and magnitude that effective response is beyond the capabilities of this County, or even the State of South Dakota, and that Federal assistance is necessary, and there is no emergency plan available to alleviate the damage and economic chaos resulting from these conditions; and

WHEREAS, Hughes County does not have the financial resources to respond to this disaster; and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners of Hughes County is aware of the sparse pastures and lack of forage crops for the feeding of livestock is necessitating the reduction / disposal of livestock herds; and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners of Hughes County is aware that row crops are stressed from lack of rain and yields will be impacted; and

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, the Board of County Commissioners of Hughes County, South Dakota, declare a natural disaster drought emergency, and it is

FURTHER RESOLVED, we, the Board of Commissioners of Hughes County respectfully petition the Governor of the State of South Dakota and the President of the United States to provide with all dispatch and remedy any state and/or federal assistance available for this type of emergency.
