

Seasonal Highway Maintenance Worker Hughes County Highway Department

Hughes County is currently accepting applications for the position of Seasonal Maintenance Worker in the Highway Department for Pierre area. This is a seasonal position, essentially from spring to fall, and would be open to ongoing seasonal employment in upcoming years. Primarily this job would entail driving a packer tractor with a road crew, and possibly mowing road ditches and spraying weeds in county road ditches. When not engaged in those tasks, this job would perform other tasks within the Highway Department.

Qualifications:

Experience and knowledge of tractor and mower operations and weed spraying operations. Must have knowledge and understanding of safety practices and procedures as they relate to equipment operations and weed spraying. The ability to operate truck, trailer, loader, blade and other county highway equipment is a plus. Must have the ability to perform heavy manual labor, follow oral and written instructions, keep records, and to work out-of-doors in all types of weather conditions. Graduation from high school or possession of a GED certificate would also be beneficial. Candidate must have the ability to perform required work duties. Previous mowing, weed spraying, highway construction or maintenance work desirable. Applicant should be able to work with little supervision and be flexible. Working hours may change periodically. Must possess a valid South Dakota drivers license, commercial driver's license preferred.
