- 1. <u>Approve minutes from December 14, 2023 meeting:</u> No corrections or changes were noted by the parties present to the minutes from the December 14, 2023 meeting. A motion was made by Commissioner Brown to approve the minutes, seconded by Mr. Tipton and the meeting minutes were approved.
